1. These auctions are defined as market class sales pursuant to Chapter 5C-4, Florida Administrative Code, "Admission of Animals for Exhibition."
2. All lots sold will be processed for consumption and may not be taken from the premise for any other purpose. *Lambs and goats are exempt.*
3. Each sale lot will be sold separately to the highest bidder. Bidders must use their assigned bidder number in order to be recognized.
4. The auctioneer selling will settle any disputes as to bids by declaring all bids off and reselling the animal in question.
5. Each animal will be at seller's risk until sold, but as soon as sold will be at buyer's risk.
6. This association acts only as an agent for the lamb/hog/steer/goat exhibitors and assumes no liability, legal or otherwise, to the public in general or to the buyer and seller.
7. Payment is due immediately following the conclusion of the auction or within 30 days of receiving the invoice from SEYF. The exhibitor will not be paid until the money for their animal has been received by SEYF.
8. The highest bidder (purchaser) must choose to do one of the following only:
  - **RESALE** the lamb/hog/steer/goat to the buy back agent for the resale price established through bid process at the onset of the auction.

2. All lots sold will be processed for consumption and may not be taken from the premise for any other purpose.  
**(Lambs & Goats are Exempt)**
3. Each sale lot will be sold separately to the highest bidder. Bidders must be their assigned bidder number in order to be recognized.
4. The highest bidder (purchaser) must choose to do one of the following only:
  - Send the lamb/goat/hog/steer to the SEYF pre-approved processor of your choice for your own consumption.
  - Purchase the lamb/goat/hog/steer for a charity and arrange for a SEYF pre-approved processor.
  - Resell the lamb/goat/hog/steer to the buy back agent for the resale price established through bid process at the onset of the auction.
  - Take lamb or goat home.
5. The auctioneer selling will settle any disputes as to bids by declaring all bids off and reselling the animal in question.
6. Each animal will be at seller's risk until sold, but as soon as sold will be at buyer's risk.
7. This association acts only as an agent for the exhibitors and assumes no liability, legal or otherwise, to the public in general or to the buyer and seller.
8. All animals are sold at a price per pound.
9. Processing of animal is not included in the sale price - processor will charge a separate processing fee.
